BOOKING A ROUTINE APPOINTMENT

You can contact the surgery via telephone, face to face contact or Online services, including eConsult. Our reception staff are trained in care navigation and are required to take basic details from the patient. On the day appointment requests go through our clinical triage system in which you will receive a call the same day. You can still book pre-bookable appointments if required.

ARRIVING LATE FOR AN APPOINTMENT

Please ensure that you arrive on time for your appointment or you may be asked to re-book.

CANCELLING APPOINTMENTS

Please notify the practice as soon as possible if you cannot attend your appointment, so that it can be offered to another patient.

HOME VISITS

If you require a home visit from a doctor, please inform the surgery **before 10.30am**. Home visits should only be requested when the patient is too ill to attend the Practice. The GP or nurse may phone you first to assess the problem before visiting.
